SLWLA Board of Directors on Annual Election

The Community Manager has received some emails questioning the election process this year. The process this year was no different than previous years, except that observers were invited in response to some concerns by a few community members about election integrity. After reviewing the obtainable records for the last five years, it has been determined that every lot that received a ballot this year has also received a ballot since at least 2016. As repeatedly stated on prior occasions, the ballots and lot lists are reviewed to eliminate any duplicate voting. Some of these emails additionally questioned the right of lots owned by certain builders to vote. The Board has consulted with the SLWLA attorney on this matter. There are different agreements, each dating back more than seventeen years and written by the then-incumbent developer, that address dues obligations and voting for applicable lots. However, regardless of whether or how they were cast, we have determined that these votes did not affect the outcome of the election. We appreciate the concerned members who have brought this issue to the Board. If the process that has been followed for several years needs to be updated, the Board will take appropriate action.
